



YFS TERMS & CONDITIONS

The following Terms and Conditions apply to all members and non-member participants in relation to football training, matches and events organised by Yule Football School (YFS) or its linked associated schools. The term “you” refers to players/parents/carer/guardian and “you” can be singular or plural. Please, read these terms and conditions carefully to ensure that you have understood this agreement and agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.

1 - YOUR STATUS

By placing a registration, you warrant that:

- (a) You are legally capable of entering into binding contracts; and
- (b) You are the parent or guardian of the child you are registering; and
- (c) You give full consent for this child to participate in football training sessions and/or match/s conducted by Yule Football School; and
- (d) You allow us to take photos and videos of this child during the Program, and to use such photos and videos for information and/or promotional purposes worldwide and in all types of media.

2 – FEES

Payments are due quarterly (per Term).

Payments have to be made in full, at the beginning of each term.

Payment to Yule Football School is to be made through EFT ONLY

No refunds for missed sessions will be issued.

No payment = No training

Extra fees may be applicable for tournaments/league fees, kits etc...

3 - TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP, CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS POLICY

Quarterly membership cannot be frozen unless there are mid/long-term medical reasons and/or at our own discretion.

All members have the right to cancel their membership at any time giving a (full calendar) month's written notice, either by e-mail or by written letter. Until reception of the written notice, all sessions attended or not are due and payable to Yule Football School.

In extreme weather conditions we reserve the right to cancel training at short notice to ensure the safety of the players and coaches. If possible, alternative training sessions will be laid

on at a later date to compensate. No refunds will be given.

4 - THE PROGRAM

We treat as a priority the safety and well-being of all children attending Yule Football School. Any abuse (physical or verbal) against other players, coaches, staff and members of the public will be treated with zero tolerance and will result in the immediate removal from the football training sessions and/or match/s conducted by Yule Football School.

We reserve the right to remove any person who is found to be engaged in offensive activity, the bullying of others, disruptive behaviour or for any other reason where we consider a person's behaviour is detrimental to the interests or safety of the persons attending our football program. In the event of your removal from our football program for any of these reasons no refund of any fees paid by you shall be made.

All Programs, activities, venues and travel arrangements are subject to change according to weather, venue availability and a satisfactory level of participants or other factors beyond our control. As such, we may cancel or change any program/s, should this be necessary for these reasons.

You are responsible for arranging and paying for suitable insurance to cover any injury or illness to the participant as, unfortunately, we cannot provide a refund under these circumstances. For avoidance of doubt, no refund is permitted for participant's failure to attend the program.

In all cases refunds of money received from you will usually be made by the same method originally used by you to pay for your program (EFT).

5 - PHYSICAL CONDITION OF MEMBER

Players are in good physical condition and that you know of no medical or other reason why they are not capable of engaging in active or passive exercise and that such exercise would not be detrimental to their health, safety, comfort or physical condition. Any change in medical condition **MUST** be advised to Yule Football School.

6 - LIABILITY

You assume full responsibility for any claims, losses, costs, articles or liabilities arising out of or related to your child's participation in the football training sessions and/or match/s. You accept that these activities carry with them some degree of risk both to person and property and knowing this risk, and still desire for your child to participate in these sessions. In cases of medical emergency or in the unlikely event of an accident, you release, waive and hold harmless the Yule Football School, including all member companies and its affiliates thereof, coaches, technical staff and directors from any claims, losses, damages or expenses which may arise during the football training sessions and/or match/s.

We are not responsible for indirect losses which happen as a side effect of the main loss or damage even if such losses result from a deliberate breach of these terms that would entitle you to terminate the contract.

You shall be liable for the cost of any damage to our property or facilities caused by you or by persons under your control.

Your child/ren is your responsibility before and after the football training sessions and/or match/s and will not be watched by any coach.
